This Agreement, dated as of

sets forth the terms and conditions under which the "Schweizerische Chemische Gesellschaft" (SCG) will provide the Licensee access to printed and electronic edition of CHIMIA as defined below.

A. Definitions

Licensee – The customer named in the registration process as representative of the Subscriber, which has authorized the acceptance of this license and is responsible for journal subscriptions, payment and license administration.

Subscriber may be either an individual, an institution, or a company who subscribes to or has purchased CHIMIA at the full institutional price (the "Subscription").

Subscription – The subscription covers both, printed and electronic edition of CHIMIA as well as any additional electronic content not included in the print version.

Site – All terminals and workstations owned and controlled by the subscriber in a single, geographically contiguous office building or complex or campus location within that same city plus dial-in access for authorized users as defined below via the Licensee's secure network. Access for authorized users in outlying field stations are also included in the Subscriber's Site provided they are wholly owned and run by the Subscriber.

Authorized User – current faculty, staff and students (for academic institutions) or current employees (for companies and other institutions) officially affiliated with the Subscriber at the subscriber's Site.

Walk-in User – The walk-in public using books and designated workstations under direct control and physically located in the public areas of the library facilities at the Subscriber's Site.

Access Mode – The Access Mode is the method used to authenticate a User. Depending on the technical solution provided by the Distributor of CHIMIA electronic edition, the access will either be authorized via specified Internet Protocol (I.P.) ranges agreed with SCG or alternatively by assigning a Subscription Key, which may be distributed to Authorized Users.

B. Licensed Rights

SCG grants the Subscriber and its authorized and walk-in users a one-year, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to access to the electronic edition of CHIMIA.

The Subscriber's access to the electronic edition will be authorized via the Access Mode provided by the distributor.

The rights and restrictions governing access to CHIMIA by individual users are outlined in the "Rules of Use". The "Rules of Use" must be accepted by the user.

Printed and electronic edition of CHIMIA and materials contained therein are protected by copyright. All rights not specifically granted are expressly reserved.

Single pages and figures but never whole articles may be used and distributed for classroom instructions provided that full and correct citation and copyright information is given.

The Subscriber may use the Subscription for the purpose of supporting interlibrary loan requests for non-commercial use by supplying at any one time a single copy of an article from the Subscription. The recipient of an electronic version may not forward it to anyone else.

The Subscriber may save a copy of all publications in CHIMIA throughout the Subscription periode for future use in the Subscribers intranet. Access shall be granted to Authorized Users exclusively also after termination of the Subscription.

C. Subscription Fee

Access to the Subscription will only be granted when payment for the Subscription has been received by the SCG, either from the Subscriber or the Subscriber's agent.

D. Mutual Obligations

SCG will:

- use all reasonable endeavours to make the Subscription available to the Subscriber on a continuous basis, but if access is suspended or interrupted or a fault or defect occurs which prevents access to the Subscription, the SCG's liability shall be limited to restoring access as soon as reasonably practical.

The Subscriber will:

- make reasonable efforts to make Authorized Users and Walk-in Users aware of this Agreement and especially of terms and conditions as expressed under Section H, "Rules of Use".
- verify that the Access Mode in use will only allow access inside the terms of this Agreement.
- make access available to Users only according to the Access Mode in use and undertake reasonable measures within its control to prevent access to and improper use of the electronic edition by unauthorized persons and take responsibility for terminating any unauthorized access of which it has actual notice or knowledge.
- promptly notify SCG of any copyright infringement or unauthorized usage of the electronic edition which comes to the Licensee's attention; and cooperate with SCG in the investigation of such infringement or unauthorized use.

E. Term and Termination

The Term of this License shall commence as of January 1, 2004 and be automatically renewed on an annual basis on payment of the subscription renewal fee at prices to be determined.

SCG shall have the right to terminate access to SCG by a User at any time during the Term if such User breaches the Rules of Use . The Licensee shall not be responsible for unauthorized use by Users which is without the express or implied consent of the Licensee, provided that the Licensee has taken reasonable steps to prevent such misuse and, upon learning of it, notifies SCG promptly of any such breach or infringement.

SCG may terminate this License if the Licensee materially breaches its obligations under this License and fails to cure such material breach, provided that SCG shall give written notice of its intention to terminate and shall allow the Licensee 60 days after receipt of such notice to remedy the breach.

F. Warranty and Disclaimers by SCG

To the best of SCG's knowledge, CHIMIA and the materials do not infringe upon any copyright, patent, trade secret or other proprietary right of any third party. SCG may provide Users with links to third party websites. Where such links exist, SCG disclaims all responsibility and liability for the content of such third party websites. Users assume sole responsibility for the accessing of third party websites and the use of any content on such websites.

SCG and CHIMIA and all materials contained therein are provided on an "as is" basis, without warranties of any kind, either express or implied, including, but not limited to, warranties of title, or implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

The use of CHIMIA and all materials is at the user's own risk.

Access to the electronic edition of CHIMIA may be interrupted and may not be error free.

Neither SCG or anyone else involved in creating, producing or delivering the journal or the materials contained neither in print nor electronically, shall be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, consequential or punitive damages arising out of the user's use of or inability to use the electronic or print edition of CHIMIA and all materials contained therein.

G. General Provisions

The Licensee may not assign or transfer its rights or obligations under this License except with the prior written consent of CSG.

This License shall be construed and interpreted pursuant to the laws of Switzerland.

This License constitutes the complete understanding of the parties and supersedes all prior oral and written understandings between the parties with respect to the subject matter of this License. No modification, amendment or waiver of any provisions shall be valid unless in writing and signed by both parties. Any waiver in one or more instances by either of the parties of any breach by the other of any terms or provisions contained in this License shall not be considered a waiver of any succeeding or preceding breach.

The Subscription is subject to all applicable copyright, database protection, and other rights of the copyright owner and publisher. The Subscriber acquires no ownership rights in the Subscription and all such rights remain with the copyright owner.

The place of jurisdiction is Bern, Switzerland.

This notwithstanding, SCG shall be entitled to commence legal proceedings against the licensee at his/her place of residence or before any other court of competent jurisdiction. In all these circumstances, Swiss law shall remain exclusively applicable.

H. Rules of Use

Copyright – The entire contents of the CHIMIA and each article and abstract and other material available through CHIMIA, are protected by copyright (unless otherwise indicated on the title page of the article). The User has certain rights specified below. All other rights are reserved.

Authorized Users may download, view, copy (printed or electronic) and save to hard disk or diskette and store or print out single copies of individual articles or items for their own personal use, scholarly, educational or scientific research or internal business use.

Authorized Users may distribute or otherwise make available information from the Subscription to other Authorized Users.

Authorized Users may include information from the Subscription in presentations, provided the credit “Reproduced by permission of the Swiss Chemical Society” appears on such material in such a position and typeface as to be clearly visible to the audience.

Authorized Users have the right to use, with appropriate credit, single figures, tables and brief excerpts from individual articles in their own scientific, scholarly and educational works. These may be distributed in anthologies (course packs) in printed or electronic form for use in connection with classroom instruction only. Full and correct citation and the credit “Reproduced by permission of the Swiss Chemical Society” must appear on such material in such a position and typeface as to be clearly visible to the user.

Except as provided above, the User may not:

- copy, distribute, transmit or otherwise reproduce material from CHIMIA
- store such material in any form or medium in a retrieval system
- download and/or store an entire issue of an Electronic Journal or its equivalent
- transmit such material, directly or indirectly, for use in any paid service such as document delivery or list serve, or for use by any information brokerage or for systematic distribution, whether or not for commercial or non-profit use or for a fee or free of charge - with the exception of interlibrary loan requests as defined in chapter B.

In order to protect the integrity and attribution of SCG and CHIMIA, the User agrees not to remove, obscure or modify any copyright or proprietary notices, author attribution or disclaimer contained therein or on any screen display. The User may not integrate material from CHIMIA with other material or otherwise create derivative works in any medium. This is not meant to prohibit quotations for purposes of comment, criticism or similar scholarly purposes.

If the User refuses or fails to abide by these Terms and Conditions or violates any other terms of this Agreement, SCG reserves the right in its sole discretion to suspend or terminate the User's access to CHIMIA immediately without notice, in addition to any other available remedies.

SCG is not responsible for any charges associated with accessing SCG and the Electronic Journals, including, but not limited to, any computer equipment, telephone or Internet connections and access software.

SCG may modify any of these terms and conditions at any time by providing notice in CHIMIA. The continued use of SCG shall be conclusively deemed acceptance of such modification.

SCG may provide links to third-party websites. Where such links exist, SCG disclaims all responsibility and liability for the content of such third-party websites. Users assume the sole responsibility for the accessing of third-party websites and the use of any content appearing on such websites.
