HEILBRONNER-HÜCKEL LECTURE SERIES 2010



The new Heilbronner-Hückel Lecture is jointly organised by the SCS Division of Chemical Research and the German Chemical Society (GDCh).

This year the first lecturer in this series is Prof. **Jürgen Troe**, University of Göttingen (D)

Jürgen Troe studied mathematics, physics and chemistry at the Universities of Göttingen and Freiburg im Breisgau. He received his doctoral degree in Göttingen in 1965 and he habilitated there in 1968. He became full professor at EPF Lausanne in 1971 and full professor and director of the Institute of Physical Chemistry at the University of Göttingen in 1975. In parallel to his university professorship he became director and scientific member of the Max-Planck-Institute for Biophysical Chemistry in 1990 and president of the Laser-Labs Göttingen in 1997.

Jürgen Troe was elected honorary professor at EPFL in 1976, and received honorary doctorates from the Universities of Bordeaux and Karlsruhe. He has received numerous honours worldwide and is member of the German Academy of Sciences/Leopoldina, the Berlin Brandenburg (formerly Prussian) Academy of Sciences as well as Foreign Honorary Member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

The research interests of Prof. Troe mainly concentrate on reaction kinetics, photochemistry, spectroscopy, laser chemistry, as well as atmospheric and combustion chemistry. He thus covers in great depth an exceptionally large range of research problems. He also served the scientific community in numerous important functions and has retained close ties to Switzerland.

He will present a series of lectures in Basel, Bern, Zurich, and Lausanne
