MDPI (Multidisciplinary Digital Publishing Institute)

A pioneer in scholarly open access publishing, MDPI has supported academic communities since 1996. Based in Basel, Switzerland, with additional offices in Beijing, Wuhan, Barcelona and Belgrade, MDPI has the mission to foster open scientific exchange in all forms and across all disciplines. Our 197 diverse, peer-reviewed, open access journals published over 35,000 articles in 2017.

We serve scholars from around the world to ensure the latest research is freely available and all content is distributed under an open access license (Creative Commons CC BY). We aim to cover all disciplines and support researchers in all fields, including humanities and social sciences, to publish in open access form. Currently 112 out of 197 journals are indexed in Web of Science (39 in the SCIE and 73 in the ESCI).

The driving principles behind everything that we do are:

Sustainability

In addition to being a key theme in our journals, we support sustainability by ensuring the long-term preservation of published papers, and the future of science through partnerships, sponsorships and awards.

Simplicity

All of our tools and services can be found in one place and prioritize user-friendliness. Simple processes keep our editorial process highly efficient.

Accessibility

We offer access to science and the latest research to readers free of charge.

Speed

We publish fast to ensure the latest research is rapidly disseminated, using thorough, precise editorial work. A first decision was provided to authors in 25 days and papers were published in 50 days from submission to online publication (average time across all MDPI journals in 2017).

Service

We aim to provide a service that supports scholars and their work. By offering a range of different options, including journal publication at mdpi.com, early publication at preprints.org and conferences on Sciforum.net, we support scientific communities worldwide to make a positive impact on research.

Flexibility

By listening to feedback from authors, editors and readers, we can make changes to better meet the needs of our research community and keep MDPI relevant.

Chemistry and materials science is our strongest subject area with over 50 journal titles in chemistry and related fields. *Molecules* is MDPI's oldest journal and one of our flagship journals, with an Impact Factor 2.861 and publishing over 2,000 papers per year.

Polymers (Impact Factor 3.364) *Materials* (Impact Factor 2.654) *Catalysts* (Impact Factor 3.082) are also growing rapidly. Our journals have seen a significant growth every year due

to the service we offer to authors, meaning fast and high-quality peer-review process, fast publication (approx. 50 days on average from submission to publication across all journals in 2017), immediate responses to scholars, and flexibility. In parallel with the rapid increase in size, many MDPI journals also see a steady increase in Impact Factors every year and are indexed in Web of Science early after their inception.


